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Music for Grades 1-5

1. Body percussion, rhythms, and use percussion instruments
2. Table rhythms and incorporate the use of vocalization, percussion instruments
3. Singing games from *Jump, Jim, Joe* by New England Dancing Masters: Building classroom community (If permitted in the Reopening plan 20-21)
4. Read chords and tablature for the ukulele (3rd, 4th, and 5th grades) Music and instruments are provided. Students will be assigned their own individual ukulele to use in the classroom. Ukuleles may be checked out to take home through Mrs. Sanders.
5. Learn to read music: Recorder Karate program for 1st and 2nd grade. Music and recorders are provided. Each student will be assigned their own recorder for use in the classroom. I will only be teaching this part of the curriculum if it is permitted by the health and safety standards for the pandemic.
6. I recommend that students who are interested in practicing at home purchase a recorder. Not until we are allowed to play recorders in the classroom.
7. Performance: Students are not required to attend the performance, but it is a good way to showcase what they have learned in music class
